



## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- ▶ The COVID-19 pandemic appears to be gaining momentum in West Africa, with +23% increase in new cases recorded during the week. Preventive restrictions are being maintained or tightened.
- ▶ Coordinated responses to support the agricultural sector and regional trade: on 18 June, **ECOWAS** presented the World Bank's new USD 500 million, West Africa Food Systems Resilient Program (FSRP); announced on June 8, the AfDB's Feed Africa Response to Covid-19 (FAREC) will support, among other things, the provision
- ► Fertilizer distribution continues even "with COVID". Ghana, Nigeria, and Senegal are preparing to import remaining volumes to
