### THE COMMUNITY AGRICULTURAL DOMAINS PROJECT DISCOVERS MICRODOSING

The Community Agricultural Domains (CAD) project involves the creation of 11 domains throughout the country, with the first in the Sédhiou Region, Séfa. These domains are places of economic competitiveness and integration for women and young people; but they are also for private promoters wishing to invest in the sector: both in its production activities and in agricultural transformation and services.

Covering an area of 2,000 hectares, local women's and youth groups carry out income-generating activities based on field crops, vegetables, livestock, and fish farming.

Having received positive feedback on microdosing (MD), which consists of placing 3 g of fertilizer in a small hole 5 cm from the plant, CAD managers

asked the Feed the Future Senegal Dundël Suuf project to strengthen the capacities of its technicians and producers in this technology.

In response, a training session was organized in the CAD conference room, attended by 29 people, including 13 young people and 8 women.
